

Each day you can ski one of the six amazing "Super Ski Pass" areas—with guaranteed snow! Or opt for a day to explore the town itself or the Olympic sites in Igls—why not take a bobsled run? At night, Innsbruck has plenty of lively pubs, bars and dance clubs for those with the energy left—there is even a full service casino—Good Luck!

Wander the streets of the Old City or spend your time in the mountains surrounding the city—it truly is an experience you will never forget. There will be an option to pick up your vouchers at the ski swap, at a meeting in late November or early December (up to the Christmas party) or add an additional payment with your vouchers to cover the cost of shipping and handling (estimated to be ~\$10 per order). Vouchers/Bulk tickets are considered "cash" and cannot be insured, but Dave will get tracking numbers. DSC will NOT be responsible for any vouchers/bulk tickets shipped/mailed.
